Established in 1894, the **Nebraska Sheriffs' Association (NSA)** is the oldest professional law enforcement organization in Nebraska. As you know, Nebraska sheriffs have many responsibilities, including jail issues, civil process questions, being aware of legislation that impacts the Office of the Sheriff and law enforcement in general, court security and prisoner transportation, just to name a few. The NSA provides them with a network of sheriffs and other professionals, as well as training opportunities for sheriffs and their personnel. Our efforts are designed to assist NSA members in providing quality law enforcement services for Nebraska citizens.

As part of a program on impairment presented in communities by sheriff's office personnel, the Fatal Vision simulator goggles permit people to experience firsthand the potentially fatal consequences of alcohol and drug impairment without consuming potentially dangerous or illegal substances. The program has been extremely effective in sensitizing our youth to the dangers of alcohol and drug abuse.
